FIELD TRIP - WORKSHOP - MEETING

The first general six-monthly meeting of the MEDWILDFIRELAB project, being the second project meeting after the inaugural one, will be held in Athens, Greece on May 15th, 2015, from 09:30 to 18:00.

The meeting will be preceded by a field trip to the southeast of Athens on May 13th for the MEDWILDFIRELAB members. It will start at 08:30 am with pickup from the hotel. During this trip

they will visit forest areas that have burned in the last few years. Many of them are characterized as "Wildland-Urban Interface". The trip will end at the ancient temple of Poseidon at Cape Sounio, at the southern tip of the Attica Peninsula and a special lunch at a nearby restaurant. Return to Athens will be by a scenic 1-hour drive by the coast, reaching the city around 18:00.



Also, on May 14th, from 09:30 to 14:00 a workshop on "Current and

Future Training on Wildland Fire Management" will be carried out in the frame of MEDWILDFIRELAB project. The language will be English. Members of the project consortium are expected to contribute to the workshop.


VENUE

ACCOMODATION

We have received a special offer from two 4-star hotels which are relatively close to the Institute (about 15-20 minutes on foot, less than 5 euros by taxi), for the dates May 12th (arrival) to May 16th (departure). The two hotels are:


